At Speakeasy we have had recently focussed a lot on **technology**

Using it can be **hard for people with aphasia and carers too.**

But it is essential in many aspects of our lives and it can be a help too.

Our members with aphasia and our carers have told us what they want to know

Here are some of the suggestions

- Putting an **ICE number** in your phone - someone who the emergency services will ring **In Case of Emergency**
- Turning on a services that helps you to **find your phone** if you lose it. Or for someone to find you!
- Making the **screen** look different
- Switching **off distracting things** from websites.
- Using **voice control** - speaking into your phone to tell it what to do

We also plan to run a Tuesday session on **how to spot scams and avoid being taken in**

Trustees

Speakeasy is a **charity.**

We are always planning new things.

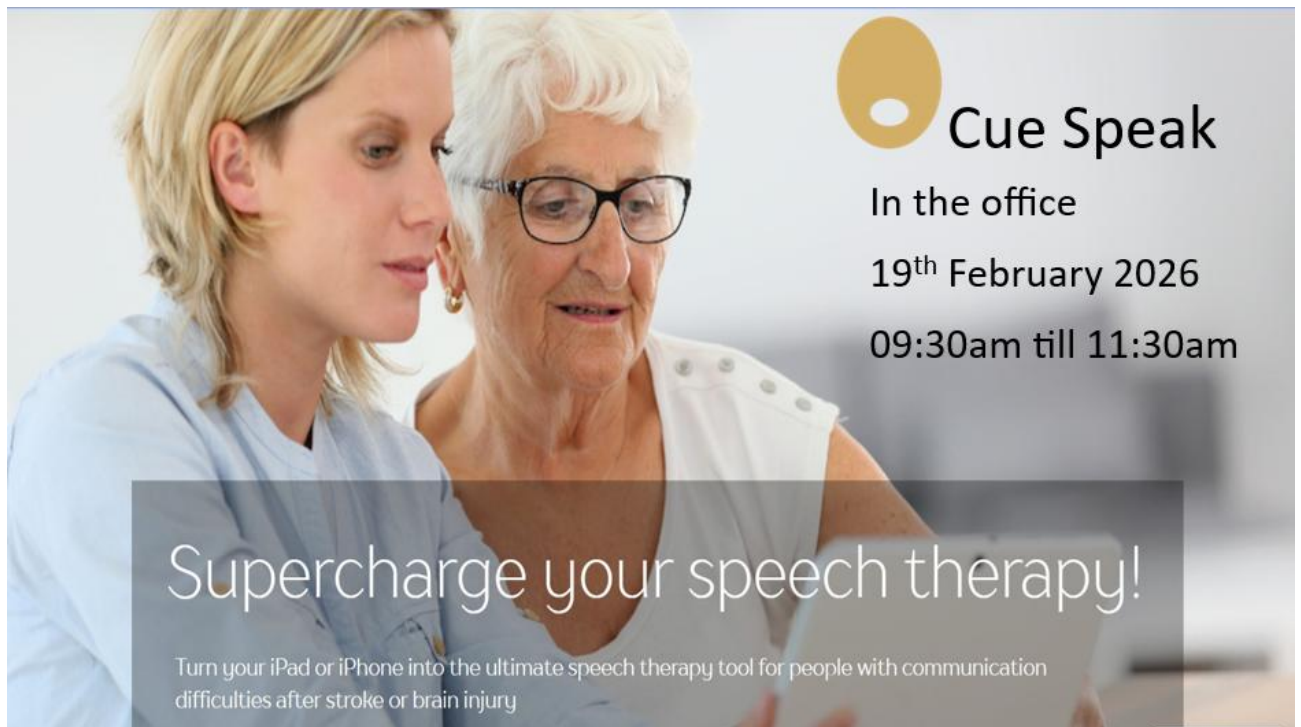
Let us know if you have ideas about what we should do.

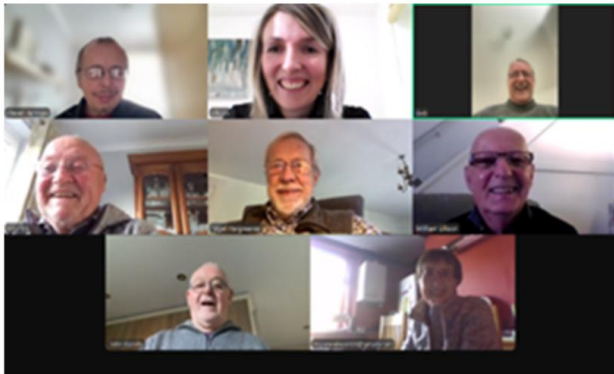
We are currently completing a questionnaire so that you can tell us what you think of Speakeasy and what difference we make. This helps us plan the right activities to help you
